

There are 3 different ways to be involved with packing life saving food for children:

1. **PUBLIC SESSIONS.** These packing sessions are open to the public and conducted at our "Factory" in Cincinnati. Volunteers are registered on a first come, first serve basis. Once all available positions are filled, (approximately 200), the session is closed. Our goal is to maintain a family friendly program for people of all ages. Since all of the food ingredients are purchased at market prices, registration preference will be given to groups that are able to help financially. 2. **PRIVATE SESSIONS.** These packing sessions are closed to the public and conducted at our "Factory" in Cincinnati. They are reserved by a group, business, school, church, etc. The group pays for the ingredients at 25¢ per meal or \$120 per adult participant unless other arrangements have been made by the registering group. The group enjoys the full "Factory" experience of a public session but only with their group. The acclaimed Red Shirt Team is there to coach and encourage the participants. These special sessions can accommodate up to 250 people with some members working in the Production and Assembly Areas. For more details, see <http://www.achildshopeintl.org/Reserve.html>
3. **MOBILE SESSIONS.** We take the "Factory" on the road as a Private Session to your church, business, school or neighborhood. The group pays 28¢ per meal to help cover the additional costs like transportation expenses, etc. These events have varied in size from small to hundreds of people.
